Payment Responsibility

Adult learners are personally responsible for paying all above mentioned fees, whether or not another entity (employer, relative...) provides full or partial financial support. If any third party fails to fulfill the payment obligation, adult learners are obliged to pay the remaining expenses. Whether the payment is made by a third party (employer, relative, etc.) or adult learners, the adult learners participating in the training are obliged to ensure that payments are done on time and in full.

Refund Policy

90% of the tuition fee and registration fee can be refunded within seven working days after payment.

After 7 working days from the date of the payment, no registration fee and tuition fee can be refunded.

Credential Requirement

Infant/Toddler adult learners

- 1 Complete the academic hours
- 2 Attendance (90%) and participation in summer classes and weekend seminars
- 3 A practicum in one of the following classrooms: birth-18 months; 18 months to 3 years; birth to three years.
- The practicum with a minimum of 540 hours during 9 consecutive months, and the practicum site must meet AMS and EMTTA standards
- 5 Uninterrupted Montessori work period of at least 2 hours per day.
- 6 A minimum of three qualified consultation evaluation visits by a Field Consultant
- 7 Satisfactory completion of assignments and written and/or oral exams
- 8 At least a high school diploma for the Associate Credential
- 9 B.A for the Full Credential if the degree's program length was at least three years and if the degree is recognized by a credential evaluation service

Early Childhood adult learners

- 1 Complete academic hours
- 2 Attendance (90%) and participation in summer classes and weekend seminars
- 3 A practicum in a 3-year, multi-age classroom

- The practicum with a minimum of 540 hours during 9 consecutive months, and the practicum site must meet AMS and EMTTA standards
- 5 An uninterrupted Montessori work period that is at least 2.5 hours per day
- 6 A minimum of three qualified consultation evaluation visits by a Field Consultant
- 7 Satisfactory completion of assignments and written and/or practical exams
- 8 At least a high school diploma for the Associate Credential
- 9 B.A for the Full Credential if the degree's program length was at least three years and if the degree is recognized by a credential evaluation service

Other requirements

- AMS Credential for an adult learner whose degree is earned in a country outside of the United States and the degree has been evaluated and deemed equivalent to a U.S. bachelor's degree.
- AMS International Credential for an adult learner whose degree is earned in a country outside of the United States and is not equivalent to a bachelor's degree in the US. The International Credential will state the name of the home country of the recipient "BA or BS Awarded in country name."
- 3 AMS Associate Credential for an adult learner having completed secondary education. The adult learner may also have some postsecondary education but has not completed a bachelor's program.

AMS Professional Development Requirements

AMS requires that holders of AMS credentials issued on or after July 1, 2013 complete 50 hours of professional development every 5 years for the credential to remain active. The first 5-year period begins with the date the credential was issued. If professional development hours are not completed within the 5-year period, the credential will be considered inactive until the requirement is met.

The credential holder must keep a record of his or her professional development and be able to provide print or electronic verification of the event host, location, date, topic, presenter(s), and number of hours attended. For this purpose, the credential holder is welcome, but not required, to use the AMS Professional Development Form.

To maintain an active credential, verification of professional development is to be submitted to AMS 30 days in advance of the 5-year anniversary of the issuance of the credential, and every 5 years thereafter.

AMS Practicum site requirements

Please note that the practicum site for IT and EC applicants should meet the standards listed below.

Montessori Work Schedule

Daily Montessori work schedule of a minimum of 2.5 continuous hours for EC.

Daily Montessori work schedule of a minimum of 2 continuous hours for IT.

Non-Discrimination policy

The site must have a written non-discrimination policy for children and staff.

Licensing

The site must meet all local and state regulations.



Job Description /Contract

The site must provide a job description and a contract of agreement acceptable to the site, the adults learner, and the teacher education program.

Cooperation

The site must agree to cooperate with the teacher education program in all matters relating to the practicum.

Mixed age range of class

IT: Birth to 3 years of age and at least 7 children in the classroom.

EC: The class should contain children in the full 2.5 through 6 age span. at least 7 children in the classroom.

Classroom environment

The environment must be designed and equipped to meet the developmental needs of the children served. The classroom must include child-sized furnishings and a full array of recommended Montessori materials for the age range of the class.

Adult learner

EC and IT courses are open only for teachers who work in the classroom full time during the practicum. Academic leaders and principals are welcome to consider Admin course.

Continuity

The practicum site must support adult learners practice what they learned within their internship. EC/IT course adult learners need to stay in one class 9 month continuously until meets 540 hours, they cannot change their practicum classroom/school in any circumstances.
